- [01] Computer use among students has increased dramatically in the last few years. Many universities now require a computer and computer literacy for enrollment. (a) When questioning about computer use most students report (b) discomfort such as dry eyes, neck and shoulder tightness, back pain and exhaustion. Students describe (c) similar symptoms as those reported by employees using computers. (d) These symptoms associated with computing are labeled repetitive motion injury (RMI).
- [02] There are some good reasons (a) for speaking freely about the possibility of dying to those with fatal conditions. (b) An ill person who strongly doubts approaching death, but is denied the least opportunity to question or discuss this, can feel cruelly isolated if the people around the patient remain silent. The patient may be surrounded (c) by people whose every apparent word or action is designed to deny or avoid the fact that death is approaching, and therefore (d) the patient has an awareness of being deceived.
- [03] In the last decades of the eighteenth century, and in the first half of the nineteenth century, (a) the number of words, which are now of capital importance, came for the first time into common English use, or (b) where they had already been generally used in the language, acquired new and important meanings. (c) There is in fact a general pattern of change in these words, and it is possible (d) to look at the wider changes in life and thought to which the changes in language evidently refer.
- [04] In recent years (a) people in different parts of the world have noticed unusual changes in weather patterns: milder winters, hotter summers and an increase in irregular climate phenomena such as flooding and typhoons. (b) While these phenomena may of course be attributed to natural occurrences, (c) there can nevertheless be no doubt that modern man is making matters worse by his ruthless exploitation of our precious planet's resources and (d) his lack of concern for the effect of modern life to the environment. The destruction of the rainforest is one example of this and man's dependence on the motorcar is another.

[05] We think that children these days, ranging from infants to adolescents, (a) communicate with other people more frequently than they used to. Or their communication may have greatly changed in quality. There are an increasing number of (b) youngsters who avoid associating closely with others because they do not want to be hurt. (c) Not a few students speak deliberately and politely to show that they do not want to become friendly with the listener. (d) On the other hand, such students sometimes prove too insensitive to understand others' feeling.
